BACH at Christmas

Another exploration of Bach's splendid Christmas music is long overdue. The radiant joy of *Christmas Oratorio* (*Parts i-iii*) will be here complemented by the exuberant *Magnificat*, complete with the extra seasonal movements which were removed after the first performance. As well as the glorious writing for voices these works also feature some of Bach's most colourful instrumental writing. The world of the Bethlehem shepherds is evoked by an oboe quartet and the whole ensemble is topped by the distinctive gleam of Bach's high trumpet parts.

Based in Surrey, the Ripieno Choir is an established ensemble of thirty voices specialising in early music, which has performed in Europe, South Africa and the USA.
